### MAINTENANCE, CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATIONS ACTIVITIES

Winter maintenance and construction activities have been completed and the focus has switched to operations with water demands significantly increasing due to unusually dry conditions. April water production exceeded 1,300 acre-feet and was significantly higher than last year when 792 acre-feet were produced. Over the past months, Distribution staff has updated District facility maps with global positioning system (GPS) data points for all fire hydrants. Presently, GPS data collection is underway for all water meter locations.

Sandblasting and recoating of the Cow Creek I storage tank interior and exterior has been completed. The tank was sanitized and returned to service on March 25<sup>th</sup>. Additionally, the District's shop building has been constructed with only electrical work remaining before completion.

### DISTRICT PERSONNEL

The District has 28 total employees in four divisions: Administrative – 8; Engineering – 3; Water Treatment – 6; Water Distribution - 11. Despite substantial growth in the number of customers and increased complexity and regulatory issues, the District has not increased the total number of employees for over a decade.
